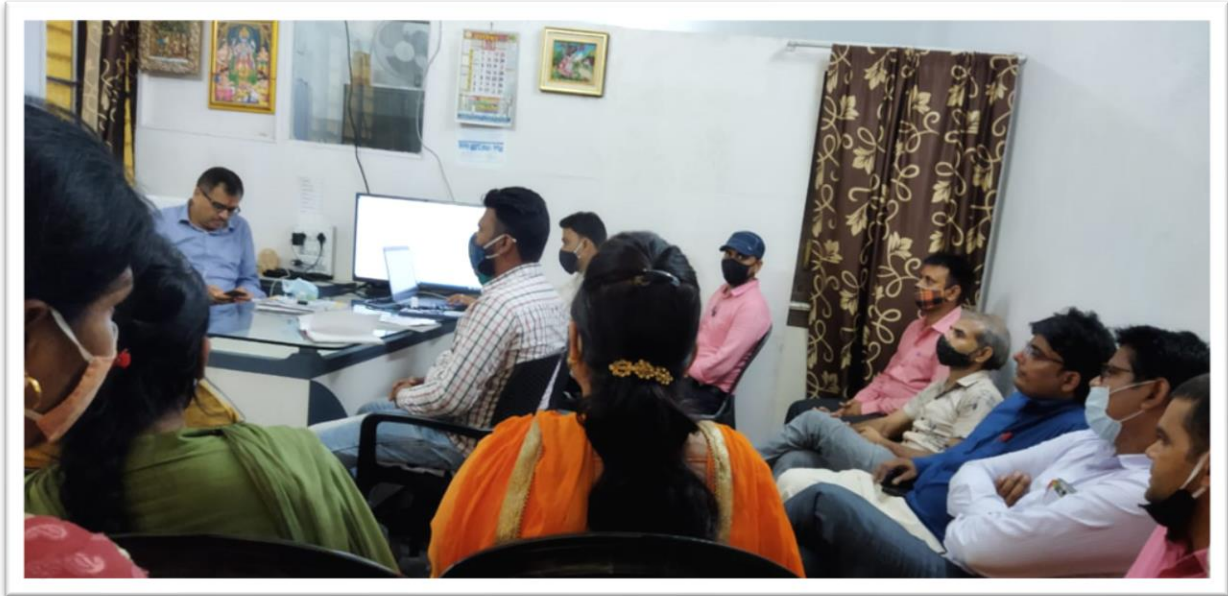
REPORT On TEACHING/ NON-TEACHING ORIENTATION PROGRAM




